H - Hunting Stipulations

*H Hunters allowed to hunt off horseback.

L - Landowner Coupon Info

*L Prairie dog hunting allowed.

M - Hunting Dogs

*M Dogs must be under owner's control.

P - Predator Hunting Info

*P Predator hunting allowed during daylight hours only.

R - Restrictions on Species/Sex

*R6 No trapping allowed.

S - State Land Info

*S State lands are enrolled in this Walk-in Area. All access restrictions apply.

T - Trapping Limitations

*T No trapping allowed.
