

GAME BIRD CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN

Prior to game birds being imported into Wyoming, this Game Bird Certificate of Origin shall be mailed to: Wyoming Game and Fish Department, Attn: Permitting Officer, 5400 Bishop Boulevard, Cheyenne, WY 82006-0001.

The game birds or game bird eggs listed below and premises of origin are operated by me and are free of infectious, contagious and communicable diseases. Diseases include, but shall not be limited to, Newcastle disease, Salmonella pullorum, avian cholera, duck viral enteritis, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, and avian influenza. No game bird within the flock of origin is known to be infected with or to be exposed to avian tuberculosis. Game birds and premises of origin shall have been free of said diseases for at least one (1) year immediately preceding the date of shipment into the state and the premises have not experienced an undiagnosed mortality of more than ten percent (10%) of the game birds during the same one (1) year period. Minimum requirements specified in Chapter VIII, Import Proclamation Pertaining to Livestock, Poultry, Other Animals and Certain Biologics, obtainable from the Wyoming Livestock Board (307-777-7515) shall be met.

All wild birds of the subfamilies Tetraoninae (grouse) and Meleagrididae (wild turkey) shall test negative within thirty (30) days prior to importation for Mycoplasma gallisepticum, M. synoviae, M. meleagridis, and Salmonella pullorum (Pullorum Disease) and S. gallinarum (Fowl Typhoid). Additionally, if the state of origin has documented cases of Newcastle Disease or Avian Influenza in the past two (2) years, all wild birds of the subfamilies Tetraoninae (grouse) and Meleagrididae (wild turkey) should be tested for these diseases. For groups of grouse to be imported from the same source, in a single shipment, testing shall be required for at least twenty-five percent (25%) of those birds provided that at least twelve (12) grouse are tested (i.e. testing shall be required on twelve (12) grouse or twenty-five percent (25%) of the shipment, whichever number is larger).

This form is <u>in addition</u> to the requirement that a copy of the **certificate of veterinary inspection** be forwarded immediately to the animal health official of the state of origin for approval and transmittal to the Wyoming State Veterinarian and Wyoming Game and Fish Department. A copy of the certificate of veterinary inspection **shall accompany and be in the possession of the driver or person in possession of the game birds or game bird eggs** shipped into or in any manner transported into Wyoming. Please refer to Chapter 40, Wyoming Game and Fish Commission Regulation Governing Commercial Game Bird Farms for additional requirements.
