STOP INVASIVE SPECIES

You can stop the spread of invasive species. Before and after you waterfowl hunt, follow these simple steps:

✓ DRAIN Drain all water from your boat, hunting gear, and decoys.

✓ CLEAN Clean all plants, mud, and debris from anything that came in contact with water.

✓ DRY Dry all of your gear thoroughly.



Check your dog including paws, coat, and collar for any mud, plants, or animals and remove. Wash your dog with warm, clean water and brush its coat.
