


Driving Directions: Find your way to the town of Alpine located at the confluence of the Snake and Greys River in the far western part of the state. Turn east on the Greys River Road that joins with highway 89 just south of the bridge over the Snake River. This road parallels the Greys River all the way to its headwaters at the Tri-Basin Divide. The road forks there and goes to either La Barge or Cokeville. Once you reach the Forest Service boundary just east of Alpine there are lots of places to pull over and enjoy some fine fishing on this classic Western trout stream.
