




**Driving Directions:** Drive about 11 miles west from Pinedale on highway 191 to the junction with highway 189 near Daniel. Then continue on another 10 miles or so north towards Jackson until the road crosses the Green River. Immediately on the north side of the river, take the good gravel road (BLM Rd 5201) to the right. This road parallels the river for several miles and there are numerous places you drive or hike down to test the fishing. Though many of the two-track roads down to the river are passable by a passenger car (when the weather's good), you may find a high clearance vehicle a good choice in some places. The instream flow segment is entirely on public land so no permission is needed.
