



Driving Directions: North Piney Creek is easy to find and is accessible by good paved or gravel roads in all seasons except winter. To get there, take the Middle Piney Road (Highway 350) west about 18 miles from the town of Big Piney. Just after crossing the Forest Service boundary, the road splits and you should take the right hand fork north about 6 miles. You can get a good map of this and other streams and roads in the area by requesting a map of the Bridger-Teton National Forest at any Forest Service office in Big Piney, Pinedale, Kemmerer, Afton, or Jackson.
