

The X-Stream Angler Program

Do you need an incentive to explore Wyoming's fabulous trout fishing – to visit some of the most popular rivers or discover secluded mountain streams?

Do you ever wonder where the state has obtained instream flow water rights that'll sustain those fisheries for generations to come?

The X-Stream Angler program was developed to help anglers and others become more familiar with the many streams where instream flow water rights have been secured. The program is intended to increase your appreciation of the importance of instream flow rights for helping maintain our fisheries, economy, and high quality of life.

Fish in at least three instream flow segments, fill out the application form in this brochure (or print one out at the instream flow web site shown below), attach a photo of each stream fished, and submit the application to be officially recognized as an X-Stream Angler.

What are instream flow water rights?

Instream flow refers to water flowing in streams. An instream flow WATER RIGHT refers to the legal means to protect water in streams for the benefit of fish based on the same laws and policies used for other kinds of water rights. Instream flow water rights are one way the Game and Fish Department manages habitat to maintain or improve important fisheries for the citizens of Wyoming. Water is owned by all the people of the state, so it is only logical that some water in some streams is permanently dedicated to the enjoyment of all the state's citizens.


