





South Wind River Mule Deer Crucial Winter Range




Lander Front Mule Deer Habitat Improvement Project

Habitat Types Mapped in mid-2000s – over 250,000 acres




**Potential Habitat Enhancement Projects Identified



WGF Strategic Habitat Plan Map






Mixed Mountain Shrub Communities
