



PERMANENT PERMIT APPLICATION FORM FOR HUNTERS WITH QUALIFYING DISABILITY

STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

Wyoming Statute 23-2-104(f) and 23-3-306(a).

PERMIT VALID FOR:

Hunters with a qualifying disability shall be allowed to shoot from a stationary vehicle to take wildlife after receiving from the Department a free permit for a hunter with a qualifying disability. The permit shall not allow a hunter to hunt, shoot, or attempt to take any wildlife from any public road or highway.

PERMIT FEE:

No charge.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PERMIT:

Applicant may qualify based on physician's sworn statement of qualification. The physician must sign the application form indicating that the applicant has a permanent physical handicap or impairment and/or qualifying disability which necessitates him/her to:

Shoot from Vehicle Permit:

Utilize a wheelchair, cane, crutches, or some other mechanical device to assist the individual in moving to and from the vehicle.

PERMIT ISSUANCE:

Permits are issued only at headquarters in Cheyenne or at Wyoming Game and Fish Department Regional Offices located in JACKSON, PINEDALE, CODY, SHERIDAN, GREEN RIVER, LARAMIE, LANDER, or CASPER. In addition, applications can be mailed to any of the regional offices or the headquarters office.

Allow 15 business days from the day you mail your request for processing and receipt of your permit.
