

# Rattlesnake Mountain HMA 2020

- Rattlesnake Mountain Hunter Management Area provides access to hunt elk, antelope and mountain lion under limitations during specific species seasons as published in the current Game and Fish Commission Regulations.
- Rattlesnake Hunter Management Area is open for **elk, antelope and mountain lion hunting** with the following limitations:
  - **Elk Hunt Areas 23** (Type 1, 4, 6, & 7)
    - **Unlimited permission slips**
    - **Dumbell Ranch open October 11 – October 31, November 15 – December 15**
    - **Circle Bar Ranch open October 11 – October 31, November 15 – December 15**
    - **Clear Creek Cattle Company open October 11 – October 31, November 15 – December 15**
  - **Elk Hunt Areas 128** (General)
    - **Unlimited permission slips**
  - **Antelope Hunt Area 68, 69, and 72: Type 1 and 6 (unlimited permission slips)**
    - **Circle Bar Ranch open September 19 – October 31 in hunt area 68**
    - **Circle Bar Ranch open September 15 – October 31 in hunt area 69**
    - **Dumbell Ranch open September 15 – October 31 in hunt area 69**
    - **Dumbell Ranch open September 15 – October 31 in hunt area 72**
  - **Mountain Lion Hunt Area 16 (unlimited permission slips)**
    - **Dumbell Ranch open October 11 – December 15**
    - **Circle Bar Ranch open October 11 – December 15**
    - **Clear Creek Cattle Company open October 11 – December 15**
- **No archery hunting on Circle Bar Ranch, Clear Creek Cattle Company, and Dumbell Ranch.**
- **The UT Pass access road on the Dumbell Ranch will be closed to all access.**
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.
- All vehicles, including ATVs, are restricted to traveling on two-track roads only.
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, buildings or roads.
- Do not damage range improvements or harass livestock.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- No ATVs allowed on the Circle Bar Ranch.
- Camp only in designated areas on private land. No open campfires and do not litter.
- Each hunter must have a permission slip and a vehicle passes to the specific hunter management area and species they are hunting. Anyone without Department permission shall be subject to trespass charges.
- Non-hunting/ non-permitted persons may assist in game retrieval on the HMA as long as they are accompanying a permitted hunter and do not possess a firearm.
- Access is limited to individual access for hunting. Access is not granted for commercial activity, including outfitting of hunters.
- Report any wildlife violation by calling 1-877-WGFD-TIP (877-943-3847).
- Future hunting opportunities depend on hunter compliance with all ranch rules.
- **If you harvest an animal on deeded land, turn in the landowner coupon to the appropriate landowner, place in the provided container, or mail the coupon to:**
