A - Parking Information

*A All vehicles must park in designated parking areas only.

B - Use of Blinds

*B Portable blinds may be used on a daily basis. Blinds must have owner's name and contact info affixed and may not be left in the field overnight.

D - Motorized Vehicle Access on Designated Roads.

*D Motorized vehicle access limited to designated roads only. Designated roads are marked with a white arrow.

E - Motorized Vehicle Access on Established Roads.

*E Motorized vehicle access allowed on established roads only.

H - Hunting Stipulations

*H Hunters allowed to hunt off horseback.

*H1 Archery hunting only. Archers must wear fluorescent orange during the firearm season.

S - State Land Info

*S State lands are enrolled in this Walk-in Area. All access restrictions apply.
