Casper Region Antelope Hunting Season Recommendations




Antelope Seasons: General Reasoning

- Antelope herds improving – some faster than others
- Fawn ratios have been better the past two years
- Some areas now at or above objective
- Other areas still below objective and slowly improving

Management Actions:

- 1) Increase doe/fawn licenses where over objective
- 2) Slight increase of buck licenses to maintain ratio
- 3) Maintenance / same seasons everywhere else to allow continued growth

Casper Region Deer Hunting Season Recommendations



Mule Deer Seasons

General Reasoning:

- Mule deer herds are slowly improving in general
- Fawn ratios much improved the past two years
- Buck ratios are increasing or maintaining
- Average winter conditions this year
- Need more years of good fawn production and survival for continued herd growth

Management Action:

- 1) Continue low / no doe harvest in all hunt areas
- 2) Maintain similar seasons in most hunt areas
- 3) Continue APR to constrain buck harvest in Area 66
- 4) Conservative increases of buck tags in Areas 34 and 89

White-tailed Deer Seasons


General Reasoning:

- WTD herds still down in most places, except Black Hills
- WTD found along riparian areas and agriculture (i.e. mostly private lands)
- No observed outbreaks of EHD/Bluetongue in 2015
- Numbers are down and thus private land access is down

Management Action:

- 1) Reduce licenses where access is reduced
- 2) Increase licenses where WTD numbers are up
- 3) Some changes for licenses shared between hunt areas around Casper

Special Archery Deer

Archers with general deer licenses shall only hunt in those areas **specified in Chapter 2 as** open to hunting with a general license and may **take any deer only** take the sex and species of deer set forth by the limitations as specified in Section 2 of this Chapter.



Youth Deer Seasons

Youth who possess a full priced youth license may take any deer during an antlered deer **only** season **subject to the species limitation of their license** in the hunt area(s) where their license is valid as specified in Section 2 of this Chapter. **However, no youth hunter shall take a mule deer during a season in which their license type is valid for white-tailed deer as specified in Section 2 of this Chapter.**

Elk Seasons


General Reasoning:

- Local elk populations are above objective
- Elk movements / access can change depending on weather
- Public desire for longer seasons, split seasons, etc to maximize harvest opportunity
- Address agricultural damage issues wherever needed
- Multiple areas experienced record harvest in 2015

Management Action:

- 1) Maintain high cow/calf harvest
- 2) Keep seasons long to maximize opportunity and address damage
- 3) Use split season to allow elk movement to accessible areas
- 4) Continue managing for good bull quality in the region

Additional Elk Licenses

For elk, no person shall apply for and receive more than one (1) full price (General, Type 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 9) and one (1) reduced price (Type 6, 7 or 8) license through the initial drawing. After the initial drawing, a person may apply for and receive up to a total of three (3) elk licenses, of which no more than one (1) shall be a General, Type 0, 1, 2, 3 or 9 license. However, no person shall apply for and receive more than a total of three (3) elk licenses in a single hunting season.








Chapter 2 (General Hunting Regulation) Changes

Use of Aircraft to Spot or Locate Wildlife. No person shall use any aircraft with the intent to spot, locate and aid in the taking of any August 1 through January 31 of the following calendar year. Nothing in this Section shall apply to the operation of an aircraft in a usual manner where there is no attempt or intent to locate any game animal, such as aircraft used for the sole purpose of passenger transport.

Disabled Hunter Seasons

- **Hunters participating in a disabled hunter season extension shall be in possession of a Disabled Hunter Permit which shall be immediately produced for inspection upon request of an officer authorized to enforce this regulation.**








Elk Hunt Areas and Herd Units - 2014




South Bighorn Elk Herd Unit Mid-winter Counts & Harvest


