Starting in 2013, the Wyoming Game and Fish Department began to track youth attending events like this as to their involvement in hunting and fishing in future years. To facilitate this, participants and their parent are asked to provide a Sportsman ID number. This number will be their number for all future Game and Fish License purchases. If the participant does not have one, a Sportsman ID number will be assigned and a card with an assigned number will be provided at the event check in. In order to assign a Sportsman ID number, participants must provide their legal name and a date of birth on the registration form.

Medicine Lodge Kids Outdoor Day Adult Assistance Needs

Medicine Lodge Kids Outdoor Day is in need of adult volunteers for its activities. There are many ways to help out.

They include:

Outdoor Day activity instructor or assistant instructor – teach an activity during the event – requires 4 – 8 hours on day of event. (All instructors' children will be admitted to the event free of charge)

Outdoor Day group leader or assistant group leader – supervises group of 6-8 kids during the event, provides transportation to activities – requires 9 hours on day of event (without group leaders we cannot hold the event)

Outdoor Day lunch serving and clean up – help serve lunch, fill coolers with ice and water at the Outdoor Day event – requires 2 - 8 hours on day of event

Outdoor Day set up and clean up – assists in the set up and tear down of activities or lunch facilities – requires 2-6 hours on day of event (or night before event)
