

2016 GLENDO PERMIT PHEASANT HUNT REGULATIONS

Refer to Wyoming Game and Fish Commission - Chapter 11, Section 6 for further details

Hunting Hours	Daily Bag Limit
8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Three (3), any pheasant

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Glendo permits shall be required to hunt pheasants in Hunt Area 9 on each Friday, Saturday, and Monday from November 5th through November 30th.
2. A Glendo pheasant permit will **not** be required to hunt pheasants in Hunt Area 9 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays in November during the open season, nor any day in December (*Please note youth hunt days below*).
3. All persons hunting pheasants in Hunt Area 9 are required to have a valid pheasant special management permit (fee \$12.50) in their possession, regardless of the day hunted.
4. All pheasant hunters must wear one outer garment of fluorescent orange color.
5. Glendo pheasant hunters must be able to present, on request:
 1. Glendo pheasant permit (if hunting on those days when a permit is required).
 2. Valid Wyoming game bird license.
 3. Conservation Stamp (unless otherwise exempted by state statute).
 4. Hunter safety certificate (if born on or after January 1, 1966).
 5. Pheasant Special Management Permit (fee \$12.50).
6. Glendo State Park requires hunters to possess a valid day-use permit (\$4.00/day for residents, \$6.00/day for nonresidents) during the 2016 pheasant season. Day use permits can be purchased at any State Park entrance or by telephone at 1-877-WYO-PARK and annual use permits can be purchased from their website at www.wyo-park.com.

YOUTH ONLY HUNT DAYS:

- Youth only hunt days are Sundays, November 6, 13, 20, and 27 in Hunt Area 9. Only persons under the age of 18 may hunt on these dates.
- No Glendo permit is required for youth to hunt pheasants in Hunt Area 9 on youth only hunt days.
- On youth only hunt days, youth may be accompanied by an adult (youth under 14 must be accompanied by an adult) but no adult may take pheasants on youth only days.

HUNTING HOURS: 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.


COMMON VIOLATIONS:

- Shooting from vehicles, shooting across public roads or into closed areas.
- Entering more than one application for the season.
- Hunting on permit days without a valid permit for that day.
- Adults taking pheasant on youth only days.
- Hunting pheasants before or after shooting hours.
- Taking more than the allowable limit of any game species.
- Hunting on lands outside the designated area.
- Taking game for another person.
- Using motorized vehicles to hunt/pursue game.
- Failing to wear at least one outer garment of fluorescent orange while hunting pheasants.

Pheasant Area 9 is a special pheasant hunt area in Platte and Converse counties. The Wyoming Game and Fish Department releases pheasants at least twice a week during the special season in Area 9. These releases are divided among three locations around Glendo Reservoir: County Line in Converse County, approximately 10 miles north of the town of Glendo, accessed from the Glendo Highway (WY Hwy 319); Airport Bay, one mile north and east of the town of Glendo, also accessed from the Glendo Highway (WY Hwy 319); and Muddy Bay, approximately 15 miles east and north of the town of Glendo, accessed from the Glendo Park Road to Meadowdale Road, to Muddy Bay. The actual hunt area is defined as all Bureau of Reclamation Withdrawal Lands bordering and including Glendo State Park, but the three previously mentioned locations are the only areas where pheasants are released.

There are few, if any, wild birds in Hunt Area 9. Therefore, it is unlikely pheasants will be located anywhere in Glendo State Park or the adjacent Bureau of Reclamation Withdrawal Lands except in the immediate area of the release sites.
