#### **Executive Summary**

The Wyoming Game and Fish Department mandates hunters and trappers register harvested bobcats. This information is used to calculate the number of animals harvested, hunter/trapper success, and hunter/trapper effort. This information helps Game and Fish manage populations and plan next year's hunting and trapping seasons. The harvest statistics presented in this report were based on 294 successful license holders who registered their harvested bobcats. In the 2024 - 2025 hunting season, 1,213 bobcats were harvested in Wyoming.
