Bighorn Sheep Core Native Herds – Boundary Definition

The boundary for the Bighorn Sheep Core Native Herds starts on the Wyoming-Montana line on the boundary of Bighorn Sheep Herd Unit 205 and follows the eastern boundary of the following herd units in a southerly direction: Herd Unit 202, Herd Unit 205. The boundary follows the southern boundary of Herd Unit 205 in a westerly direction to Dry Creek. From Dry Creek, it follows a combination of topography, drainages and roads until southerly and then westerly until reaching the Continental Divide between Mount Lander and Nylon Peak. From this point, the boundary follows the Continental Divide northerly until intersecting Herd Unit 609. The boundary then follows the following southern Herd Unit Boundaries in a western direction until reaching the Wyoming-Idaho State Line: Herd Unit 609, Herd Unit 107 and Herd Unit 106.
