Glendo REQUIREMENTS- Check Before You Go

All pheasant hunters must wear one outer garment of fluorescent orange or fluorescent pink color which shall include a hat, shirt, jacket, coat, vest or sweater.

Glendo pheasant hunters must be able to present, on request:

- Wyoming game bird license*
- Conservation Stamp*
- Hunter safety certificate (if born on or after January 1, 1966)*
- Pheasant Special Management Permit (fee \$15.50).
- Glendo State Park requires hunters to possess a valid day-use permit (\$7.00/day for residents, \$12.00/day for nonresidents) or Annual State Parks Permit during the 2024 pheasant season. Day use permits can be purchased at any State Park entrance or by telephone at 1-877-WYO-PARK and annual use permits can be purchased from their website at www.wyo-park.com.
- Shotgun plug if needed (firearm can admit no more than 1 shell in the chamber and 2 shells in the magazine)

*unless otherwise exempted by statute or regulation

Seasonal Road Closures During Pheasant Hunt

Hunters must obey all seasonal road closures and stay on designated roads. Road closures are in place for safety reasons during the pheasant hunt. Roads will reopen for ice fishing and summer months once weather and road conditions permit. Hunters **MUST** park in designated parking areas before setting afield.

Hull Collection: It is required that all hunters collect their shotgun hulls.

YOUTH ONLY DAYS

- Youth only hunt days are Sundays: November 3, 10, 17, and 24 in Hunt Area 9. Only persons under the age of 18 may hunt on these dates.
- Youths under the age of 14 shall be accompanied by an adult. No adult shall take any pheasant during the youth only hunt days.
