#### Acknowledgements

This report was completed through a partnership with the Wyoming Game and Fish Department and the Wyoming Survey and Analysis Center at the University of Wyoming. #### **Executive Summary**

Each year the Wyoming Game and Fish Department (WGFD) surveys small game and game bird hunters to quantify harvest, hunter success, and hunter effort. This information helps the Game and Fish manage small game and game bird populations and plan next year's hunting seasons. The harvest statistics in this report are based on 9,465 survey responses sent to 49,774 license holders. The results were extrapolated to represent 57,199 licenses sold. An estimated total of 10,971 cottontail rabbits, 633 snowshoe hare, 3,375 squirrels, 45,235 pheasant, 33,133 chukar partridge, 29,152 gray partridge, 17,109 ruffed grouse, 19,809 blue grouse, 5,660 sharp-tailed grouse, 24,229 mourning doves, 56,016 ducks, and 32,587 geese were harvested in Wyoming during the fall 2024 and spring 2025 hunting seasons.
