
Acknowledgements

Executive Summary

Each year the Wyoming Game and Fish Department registers mountain goats and surveys mountain goat hunters. This information is used to calculate the number of animals harvested, hunter success, and hunter effort. This information helps Game and Fish manage mountain goat populations and plan next year's hunting seasons. The harvest statistics presented in this report were based on 30 hunters who either registered a mountain goat or responded to a harvest survey. In the 2025 hunting season, there were 27 mountain goats harvested in Wyoming.

Mountain Goat Herd Units


