1. Angi Bruce, Director, Director's Report.

Director Bruce discussed the cancellation of the Governor's Sportspersons' Conservation Forum. She stated that the goal of this event is to engage hunters and conservationists about the importance of wildlife conservation and collaboration. The Department is working to regroup what this might look like whether it is publishing webinars on different topics or scheduling something around the Mule Deer Summit or in the spring of 2027.

Director Bruce informed the Commissioner that Kelly Todd was selected as the new Policy and Planning Chief.

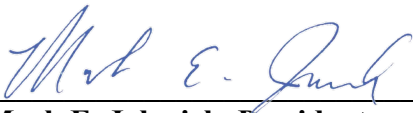
Director Bruce gave an update on the ongoing landowner license situation. It is now solely with the Travel, Recreation, Wildlife, and Cultural Resources (TRW) Committee. The next TRW Committee meeting will be held in Jackson in September. It was proposed to TRW that a group be set up of NGOs, ag producers, and hunters. The Department will bring something to TRW in September while the group makes recommendations. There was robust discussion amongst the Commissioners on setting a cap and the pros and cons to landowners and hunters.

2. Alan Osterland, Chief, Fish Division. Speas Warm and Cool Water Facility Update.

Chief Osterland provided the Commission an update on the Speas Facility.

Commissioner Lundvall moved to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
