



GAME BIRD CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN

This form is in addition to the requirement that an approved certificate of veterinary inspection be sent by the animal health official from the state of origin to the Wyoming Game and Fish Department and the Wyoming State Veterinarian. **Prior to game birds being imported into Wyoming, this completed form must be mailed to: WYOMING GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT, ATTN: PERMITTING, WILDLIFE DIVISION, 5400 BISHOP BOULEVARD, CHEYENNE, WY 82006-0001.**

The game birds listed below are originating from premises operated by me and such premises are free of infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases, including but not limited to: Newcastle disease, Salmonella pullorum, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, avian influenza, avian cholera, avian tuberculosis, west nile virus and duck viral enteritis and have been free of said diseases for the immediately preceding twelve (12) consecutive months. The premises have not experienced an undiagnosed mortality of more than ten percent (10%) of the game birds during the preceding twelve (12) consecutive months. All birds of the subfamilies Tetraoninae (grouse) shall test negative within thirty (30) days prior to importation into Wyoming for Mycoplasma gallisepticum, M. synoviae, M. meleagridis, and Salmonella pullorum (Pullorum Disease) and S. gallinarum (Fowl Typhoid). Additionally, if the state of origin has documented cases of Newcastle Disease or Avian Influenza in the past two (2) years, birds should be tested for these diseases. For groups of grouse to be imported from the same source, in a single shipment, testing shall be required for at least twenty-five percent (25%) (one of every four) of those birds provided that at least twelve (12) grouse are tested (i.e. testing shall be required on twelve (12) grouse or twenty-five percent (25%) of the shipment, whichever number is larger).

Disease Testing Requirements Specific to Game Birds

In addition to this certificate of origin, a certificate of veterinary inspection for all game birds and game bird eggs imported into Wyoming shall be completed and immediately forwarded to the animal health inspection official of the state of origin for approval and transmittal to:

A copy of the certificate of veterinary inspection shall accompany and be in the possession of the driver or person in possession of the game birds or game bird eggs shipped into or in any manner transported into Wyoming. Please refer to Chapter 40, Wyoming Game and Fish Commission Regulation Governing Commercial Game Bird Farms for additional requirements.

Failure to provide a game bird certificate of origin, acquire certificate of veterinary inspection or maintain disease free facilities and game birds is just cause for revocation of a game bird farm license or importation (Chapter 10) permit.
