

## Little V-H HMA 2016

- **Little V-H Hunter Management Area is open August 15, 2016 – January 31, 2017 to hunt antelope, antlerless elk, and game birds** during specific seasons as published in the 2016 Game & Fish Commission Regulations. **Also note the following exceptions:**
  - Access for elk hunting is permitted beginning **November 1** through the end of the season **ONLY**. **No elk hunting in September or October.**
  - Access for game bird hunting permitted beginning **November 1** through the end of the season **ONLY**. **No game bird hunting in September or October.**
    - **NO SAGE GROUSE HUNTING.**
  - **NO DEER HUNTING.**
- **Each hunter must have a permission slip** and a **displayed vehicle pass** to the specific hunter management area and the species they are hunting. **Anyone without Department permission shall be subject to trespass charges.** Vehicle pass should be displayed in window while hunting on the Hunter management Area.
- Access is limited to individual access for hunting of the species listed on the permission slip. **Hunting of ANY OTHER SPECIES requires written permission from the landowner.**
- **Preseason scouting is not permitted.** Access is restricted to the specific season dates and the restrictions on the permission slip.
- **Hunt on foot or horseback only.** Vehicle access is allowed only on the County Road as indicated on the accompanying map. **All other roads are closed.**
- **NO ORVs** are permitted on the Hunter Management Area.
- Non-hunting/non-permitted persons may assist in game retrieval on the HMA as long as they are accompanying a permitted hunter and do not possess a firearm.
- **No hunting within 1/4 mile (440 yards) of residential buildings.**
- Abide by all signs and posted areas. Some pastures or areas may be posted closed to hunting for certain periods of time because of livestock presence.
- **No camping and no campfires.** Hunters are reminded that camping is not allowed on state trust lands.
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings. Do not damage range improvements or harass livestock. Leave gates as you find them.
- Report any wildlife violation by calling 1-877-WGFD-TIP (877-943-3847).
- **No collection of artifacts, rocks, antlers, bones, etc. is permitted.** This area is open to the privilege of antelope and game bird hunting only. Hunter Management Areas are private property and only landowners may allow other activities, such as trapping, antler hunting, photography, hiking, etc.
- Future hunting opportunities depend on hunter compliance with all ranch rules. Any violation will result in immediate loss of access privileges.
- **Little V-H Hunter Management Area is located adjacent to Kirby Creek Hunter Management Area. Hunters should note that each Hunter Management Area requires a separate permission slip.**
