

- The PK Lane Hunter Management Area is open September 1 – December 31 to hunt elk in Hunt Area 37 during specific species season as published in the current Game & Fish Commission Regulations.
- The PK Lane Hunter Management Area is open for **263 first come, first serve elk hunters** with the following limitations:
 - **Elk Hunt Area 37 Type 9 (Archery) Only Valid for Cow or Calf Elk:**
 - September 1 - 3 (3 permission slips)
 - September 4 - 6 (3 permission slips)
 - September 7 - 9 (3 permission slips)
 - September 10 - 12 (3 permission slips)
 - September 13 - 15 (3 permission slips)
 - September 16 - 18 (3 permission slips)
 - September 19 - 21 (3 permission slips)
 - September 22 - 24 (3 permission slips)
 - September 25 - 27 (3 permission slips)
 - September 28 - 30 (3 permission slips)
 - **Elk Hunt Area 37 Type 6 Valid for Cow or Calf Elk:**
 - October 1 – 3 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 4 -- 6 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 7 – 9 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 10 – 12 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 13 – 15 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 16 – 18 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 19 – 21 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 22 – 24 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 25 – 27 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 28 – 30 and November 3 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - October 31 – November 30 (3 permission slips)
 - November 3 – November 30 (100 permission slips)

- Hunter Management Area permission slips will allow hunters to harvest elk as specified in the Ranch Rules. Permission slip holders may also harvest any small game or game bird during species season dates as published in the current Game & Fish Commission Regulations while hunting elk.
- Private land in Walker Prairie is closed to public hunting.
- No camping; day use only.
- Hunters must use the Designated Parking Area located on PK Lane - Sheridan County Road 52.
- Hunter access is allowed for walk-in foot traffic **ONLY**.
- Horses cannot be used for hunting. Horses may only be used for packing out harvested animals.
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, buildings or roads.
- Each hunter must have a permission slip and a vehicle pass to the specific hunter management area and species they are hunting. Anyone without Department permission shall be subject to trespass charges.
- Non-hunting/non-permitted persons may assist in game retrieval on the HMA as long as they are accompanying a permitted hunter and do not possess a firearm.
- Hunters must obey all Game and Fish laws and regulations. Report any wildlife violations by calling 1-877-WGFD-TIP (877-943-3847).
- Remember hunters, future opportunities depend on hunter compliance with all ranch rules as well as Game and Fish laws and regulations.
