

Savage Meadows HMA 2012

The **Savage Meadows Hunter Management Area** is open **December 1, 2012 – January 31, 2013** to hunt **antlerless elk** only, in Hunt Areas 12 & 130 in accordance with current Game & Fish Commission Regulations and with the following limitations: (*Hunters are reminded to also know and comply with all Bureau of Land Management Regulations on sections owned by the BLM.*)

- **Hunting species not listed or non-consumptive activities such as preseason scouting is prohibited.**
 - Remember, future hunting opportunities depend on compliance with all ranch rules as well as Game and Fish laws and regulations.
- **Each hunter must have a permission slip and a vehicle pass** to the specific hunter management area and species they are hunting. **Anyone without Department permission shall be subject to trespass charges.**
 - Hunters are urged to tape the vehicle pass to the inside of the windshield (out of the driver's way).
 - Non-hunting/non-permitted persons may assist in game retrieval on the hunter management area as long as they are accompanying a permitted hunter and do not possess a firearm.
- **Antlerless Elk Hunting Access** (Areas 12, 130 Type 7 licenses)
 - **Fifteen (15) permission slips** will be given out for each period as listed below, on a **first-come, first-serve basis** beginning November 20:

<i>December 1 – 9</i>	<i>December 17 – 23</i>	<i>Dec 31 – January 6</i>
<i>December 10 – 16</i>	<i>December 24 – 30</i>	<i>January 7 – 13</i>
 - An unlimited number of permission slips will be available for the period **January 14 – 31**.
- **Hunting is by foot ONLY.**
 - **Motorized travel is allowed on designated roads only.** When roads are wet or muddy, motorized access is limited to **Carbon County Road 347S and 345**.
 - Designated roads open to vehicle travel will be marked with a white arrow.
 - **On private lands**, ATVs and snowmachines may travel off of designated roads for game retrieval, if such travel does no damage to the resources of the rangeland.
 - Game retrieval is defined as the act of retrieving a harvested animal from the field to the nearest designated road.
 - ATVs or snow machines are not allowed for pursuing wounded animals.
 - **Firearms may not be carried on ATVs or snowmachines within the HMA.**
 - **Absolutely no vehicle use on hay meadows.** **Vehicles may not travel off road on BLM sections.**
- Abide by all signs and posted areas. Leave all gates as found.
- No overnight camping or campfires are allowed. No dogs allowed on the hunter management area.
- Do not litter, it is against the law. Pack it in – pack it out!
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, buildings, roads, windmills, stock tanks, or any object other than the animal you are hunting.
- Do not damage fences, range improvements, or harass livestock. Livestock has the right of way.
