

## **CHEROKEE PARK HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA-**

Open **November 22, 2024 thru January 31, 2025** for the take of **ELK in hunt area 8** during specific seasons as published in the 2024 Game and Fish Commission Regulations

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window
- Foot or horseback access is allowed
- Leave gates as you find them and ensure the **main entrance gate is always left closed and locked**
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip and do not possess a firearm
- No camping and no littering—carry out everything you bring in
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended when accessing this property

### **RESTRICTIONS**

- No take of ANY OTHER SPECIES (including predators) or any other activities (including collecting antlers) without landowner permission
- Preseason scouting is not allowed
- Access within closed areas (see map) is not allowed
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates is not allowed
- Use or construction of blinds or tree stands are prohibited
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 200 yards of, livestock, equipment or buildings
- Camping on State Trust lands is not allowed

### **CHEROKEE PARK HMA SPECIFIC RULES:**

- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year
- Hunters who possess unused Area 8 Type 6 elk license(s), in addition to the one listed on their permission slip, may take antlerless elk on the HMA during their permitted time.
- Youth Hunters may take antlerless elk without a permission slip as long as they are with a person with a current Cherokee Park HMA permission slip.
- Drive on DESIGNATED roads to the parking area
- For game retrieval only, ORVs and snowmobiles may travel beyond the parking areas and off road, if such travel does no damage to the resources of the rangeland
- Tracked ORVs or snowmobiles will likely be necessary to reach this HMA due to drifting snow on Carla's Trail. Do not drive off road to avoid drifts or puddles.

- Please fill out carcass coupon and landowner coupon. If harvested on deeded land, please deposit the landowner coupon in any coupon box on the HMA or mail to the appropriate landowner.

- CWD samples: Hunters are reminded the Department is collecting CWD samples from deer and elk.

### DEFINITIONS:

- **TAKE:** Means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or posses, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- **Established road:** means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks
- **Designated road:** means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are **closed** to motor vehicles.
- **Wet or muddy road:** all roads are closed when conditions are wet or muddy.
