

CHIMNEY BUTTE HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA (HMA)

Open **December 1, 2025—January 31, 2026** for the take of **ANTLERLESS ELK** during specific seasons as published in the current Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window
- Drive only on DESIGNATED roads (see map and definitions)
- Park only in DESIGNATED parking areas (see map)
- Some areas on the southeast side of the HMA are open to vehicles on all ESTABLISHED roads (see map and definitions)
- Foot or horseback access is allowed
- Leave gates as you find them
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended to access this property
- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year

RESTRICTIONS

- No taking of ANY OTHER SPECIES or any other activity without landowner written permission
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates or signs is not allowed
- Blinds or tree stands are not allowed. Temporary portable blinds may be used, but must be removed each night
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings
- Do not damage range improvements or harass livestock
- Camping on State Trust Lands or within the boundaries of the HMA is not allowed
- No Fishing
- No travel through HMA to take wildlife not listed on permission slip

Chimney Butte HMA specific rules:

- **The Silver Creek Ranch and Flying Fish Hook Ranch (see map) are closed to all access**
- The Eastfork Cattle Company also allows snowmobile use in Pocket Creek when deep snow is present
- Please do NOT leave entrails from harvested elk in pastures with cattle

DEFINITIONS:

- **Take:** means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or possess, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- **Established road:** means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks.
- **Designated road:** means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are **closed** to motor vehicles.
