SOLDIER CREEK HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA-

Open <u>July 11, 2024 thru July 10, 2025</u> for the take of prairie dogs, sharp-tailed grouse, partridge, doves, wild turkey, pheasant, waterfowl, rabbits, elk, antelope, deer and mountain lion during specific seasons as published in the current Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- New for 2024: Hunters need to sign in each day before hunting and report any harvest (use QR code below or follow the link found on the Game and Fish website)
- Each hunter must possess a permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a vehicle pass in the window
- This area may be temporarily closed due to military training exercises. Signs will be posted if possible prior to the closure
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings
- Foot and/or horseback access is allowed
- Leave gates as you find them
- Abide by all signs and posted areas
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may assist in hunting/game retrieval as long as they accompany a permitted hunter and do not possess firearms or archery equipment
- No littering—carry out everything you bring in.
- Hunters must obey all Game and Fish laws and regulations.
- Report any wildlife violations by calling 1-877-WGFD-TIP (877-943-3847).

NOT ALLOWED

- No motorized vehicles allowed including E-bikes
- No predator hunting
- No doe/fawn mule deer harvest permitted
- No sage grouse hunting
- Do not pick up antlers or dead heads



SOLDIER CREEK HMA SPECIFIC RULES:

- The Soldier Creek HMA is considered public land for the purpose of general license deer hunting.
- Hunters that hold a valid permission slip can take all species listed in the Soldier Creek HMA Ranch Rules with a proper license and during the season for that species. Example: If a hunter holds a Fall Turkey permission slip that hunter could also hunt Deer in October and Prairie Dogs in February along with any other species during the season printed in G&F regulations with one permission slip.
- Please clean your clothes and equipment before and after accessing Soldier Creek HMA to reduce the risk of spreading invasive grasses and weeds.
- Hunters must park in the designated parking area along Keystone Road.

DEFINITIONS:

• <u>Take</u>: means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or possess, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
