CHEYENNE RIVER HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA-

Open <u>AUGUST 15, 2025 thru January 14, 2026</u> for ELK during specific seasons as published in the 2025 Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- Each hunter must possess a permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a vehicle pass in the window
- Park in designated parking areas
- Foot access only
- No Horses
- Leave gates as you find them
- Non-hunting , non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip and do not possess a firearm
- No Camping
- No littering—carry out everything you bring in.

RESTRICTIONS

- No take of ANY OTHER SPECIES (including predators) or any other activities (including collecting antlers) without landowner written permission
- No taking or gathering of any artifacts
- Preseason scouting is not allowed
- No blinds or tree stands (temporary portable blinds may be used, but must be removed each day)
- Driving on the HMA is not allowed
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings
- Do not damage range improvements or harass livestock

CHEYENNE RIVER HMA SPECIFIC RULES:

- Cheyenne River HMA is open for any elk hunting (type 1, 3) during the special archery season (September 1 September 25)
- Cheyenne River HMA is open for cow elk hunting (type 8) during the entirety of the season besides HMA closures and the special archery dates for type 1 and 3
- South East portion of HMA will be closed August 15 September 25
- Entire HMÅ will be closed September 26 October 17, November 1 November 30

AFTER HARVEST

- Please fill out carcass coupon and landowner coupon. If harvested on deeded land, please deposit the landowner coupon in any coupon box on the HMA. Coupons can also be given to Game and Fish personal or dropped off at any regional office.
- CWD samples: Hunters are reminded the Department is collecting CWD samples from elk but is not required in this HMA

DEFINITIONS:

- <u>**Take:</u>** means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or possess, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.</u>
- <u>Designated Parking Areas:</u> means specifically marked areas for vehicles to park.
