MORTON PASS HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA-

Open <u>August 15, 2023 thru October 31, 2023</u> for the take of Antelope in hunt area 38, during specific seasons as published in the 2023 Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field.
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window.
- Hunting is foot and horseback only.
- Use certified weed free hay for your horses while on the ranches.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip and do not possess a bow or firearm.
- No camping and campfires
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended when accessing this property.
- No littering—carry out everything you bring in.

RESTRICTIONS

- No taking of ANY OTHER SPECIES (including predators) or any other activities (including collecting antlers, hiking, etc..) without landowner written permission.
- Preseason scouting is not allowed.
- Access within closed areas (see map) is not allowed.
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates is not allowed.
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed.
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, roads, fences or buildings. No shooting within 200 yards of buildings or livestock. Be especially cautious around **solar panels**.
- Do not damage fences, range improvements or harass livestock.
- No travel through HMA for the take of wildlife not listed on permission slip.
- Viscera and/or other inedible wildlife parts may not be left within 100 yards of any road or water source.
- Violation of Ranch Rules will result in denial of their access to HMA in subsequent years.

Morton Pass HMA SPECIFIC RULES:

- Persons may apply for only **one** antelope permission slip on the Morton Pass or North Crow HMA.
- Construction of blinds or pits is prohibited. Portable blinds may be used on daily basis and shall not be left overnight. (Blinds must have owners name and contact information affixed.)
- Anyone without Department permission or display the vehicle permission pass on their dash shall be subject to trespass charges.
- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year.
- Drive on **designated** roads only. (Marked by white arrow)
- Snowmobiles may be used on designated roads if snow conditions preclude use of full size vehicles.
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.

AFTER HARVEST

- The University of Wyoming does not collect landowner coupons. If you harvest an animal on this HMA, please discard the landowner coupon once you return home.
- CWD samples: Hunters are reminded the Department is collecting CWD samples from deer and elk.

DEFINITIONS:

- <u>TAKE</u>: Means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or posses, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- <u>Established road</u>: means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks
- <u>Designated road</u>: means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are **closed** to motor vehicles.
- <u>Wet or muddy road</u>: all roads are closed when conditions are wet or muddy.
