PINE DRAW HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA-

Open <u>August 15, 2023 thru October 31, 2023</u> for the take of Antelope in hunt area 47 and Deer in hunt area 70 during specific seasons as published in the 2023 Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- Each hunter must possess one page of valid permission slip while in the field.
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window.
- Hunting is foot and horseback only.
- Use certified weed free hay for your horses while on the ranches.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip and do not possess a bow or firearm.
- No camping and campfires.
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended when accessing this property.
- **No littering**—carry out everything you bring in.

RESTRICTIONS

- No take of ANY OTHER SPECIES (including predators) or any other activities (including collecting antlers, hiking, etc..) without landowner written permission.
- Preseason scouting is not allowed.
- Access within closed areas (see map) is not allowed.
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates is not allowed.
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed.
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, roads, fences or buildings. No shooting within 300 yards of buildings or livestock.
- Do not damage fences, range improvements or harass livestock.
- No travel through HMA for the take of wildlife not listed on permission slip.
- Anyone without Department permission or display the vehicle permission pass on their dash shall be subject to trespass charges.
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.

Pine Draw HMA SPECIFIC RULES:

- One permission slips allows a hunter with multiple valid area 47 pronghorn licenses in their possession to take multiple pronghorn during their permitted access period.
- Legally defined predators may also be taken during daylight hours by hunters with any current, valid permission slip for this HMA.
- Construction or use of blinds is prohibited.
- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year.
- Drive on **established** roads only.
- When roads are muddy, motorized access is limited to highways and county roads only.
- Possession or use of ORVs, as defined in WY Statute 31-1-101(K), is prohibited.
- Do not block gates or entrances.
- The hunter will be held responsible for damage inflicted to wind facilities or livestock, whether or not

• CWD samples: Hunters are reminded the Department is collecting CWD samples from deer and elk.

DEFINITIONS:

- <u>TAKE</u>: Means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or posses, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- Established road: means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks
- <u>Designated road</u>: means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are **closed** to motor vehicles.
- Wet or muddy road: all roads are closed when conditions are wet or muddy.
