To be eligible for a Wyoming game bird/small game lifetime license the applicant must be a resident who has continuously resided in Wyoming for at least 10 years immediately preceding the date of application.

To be eligible for this award the applicant must be 14 years of age on the date of application and may not be older than 18 years of age on the date of application. The applicant must reside within the boundaries of the Greybull Biologist District.

Applicants will be judged by their application qualifications and the content of their essay by a committee of five. The winning applicant will receive notification. An application form will be sent to the winning applicant. The completed application will be returned to the committee in order that the license and stamp can be awarded. Applicants may apply over multiple years. Applicants not selected will be notified by email.

Applications should be signed and dated. **Applications are accepted January 1 – April 1.**
